(no attorney is going to work less than minimum wage in billable hours) In the long run the damage that this bill will do is to allow 100,000's of dollars in attorney's fees to be paid by the carriers with complainants being limited to a very small fee... This will effect the act setting precedence for the future cases by only having the insurance carriers represented in claims cases.
