



## **Rules for the Fraternal Order of Police Lodge 93 Scholarship Awards**

1. A \$1,000.00 scholarship is to be awarded annually by the Fraternal Order of Police Lodge 93 to a deserving and qualified student. The student must be a dependant child of a Fraternal Order of Police Lodge 93 Member (or his or her widow). The member must be a member in good standing and a member of FOP Lodge 93 for at least the past twelve (12) months. The scholarship will be awarded to outstanding student(s) with the following provisions:
  - A. Biological or legally adopted.
  - B. Between 16 and 22 years of age.
  - C. Student must be a current graduating senior from high school with a grade point average of 2.5 or above.
  - D. Applied and been accepted to an accredited 2 or 4 year college, university, or other educational institution of the awardee's choice.
  - E. Student must submit a complete application form. Applicants will be judged on financial need, GPA, and scholastic achievement.
  
2. While attending college, student will maintain a GPA of 2.5 or above. The student's transcript must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee after each semester to continue receiving the \$500.00 per semester. Alternate scholastic periods will result in the award being divided by the number of semesters in the scholastic year, i.e., trimesters. The applicant is to fully understand that in accepting this scholarship that:
  - A. It must be his/her intention to complete college.
  - B. Scholarship funds are intended for tuition purposes ONLY!
  - C. An overall grade point average of 2.5 must be maintained.
  - D. Each year a renewal application must be completed and forwarded along with a transcript, in order for the scholarship funds to continue.
  - E. The scholarship will be terminated should the recipient not fulfill the above requirements.
  - F. Any deviation from this procedure must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee for consideration. Their decision will be FINAL!
  
3. Applications will ONLY be accepted by the Scholarship Committee from April 1st through June 30th of each year. Only one (1) application will be accepted per family. During the scheduled FOP Lodge 93 meeting in July, the allotted number of scholarship winners will be announced. The winners will be notified and invited to attend the scheduled FOP Lodge 93 August meeting for acceptance and presentation of the scholarship awards.
  
4. Should the Scholarship Committee receive more approved applications then the allotted amount of scholarships available, awards will be based on a lottery system. This selection process will ensure that every qualified applicant(s) has an equal and fair chance to receive a scholarship.
  
5. These rules are subject to revision each year as provided by the FOP Lodge 93 Constitution and By-Laws.
